Code of Conduct and Dress Code

CODE OF CONDUCT

The following is deemed as appropriate behavior and etiquette: -

- The rules of golf and the rules of the club must be adhered to.
- Players must show respect to fellow golfers, avoid slow play, repair divots and plug marks in greens and only use mobile phones in exceptional circumstances.

The following shall constitute misconduct:

- Disorderly, offensive or unacceptable behavior or language whilst on club premises or grounds.
- Disruption, interference or obstruction to fellow members, members of staff or any property of the club.
- Any form of harassment or discrimination against another member, visitor or member of staff.
- The use of unfair means in a competition.

BREACHES OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT BY ANY MEMBER WILL BE INVESTIGATED AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE DISCIPLINARY POLICY OF THE CLUB.

- Collarless Tops/Singlets
- Denim Wear/Combat Trousers/Cargo Pants
- Leggings/Tracksuits
- Soccer/Rugby/GAA Shirts/Sweatshirts
- Garments displaying Non-Golf Logo
- Training Shoes.

ALL GOLF CLUB STAFF ARE FULLY AUTHORISED TO REQUIRE ANY GOLFER, WHOSE DRESS DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE DRESS CODE, TO LEAVE THE COURSE. FURTHER BREACHES OF THIS CODE WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION.
